First: choose a puzzle piece from the bag, and place on the lyric sheet. Sing the song the puzzle piece covers, then use the poster tack to adhere the puzzle to the sheet. Continue selecting and placing puzzle pieces and singing until the puzzle is complete. You could do this all at once during a Family Home Evening, or choose one puzzle piece a day and complete the puzzle over several days. (We like to sing a primary song each night before family prayer, and will use this puzzle game for choosing.)

Second: take a small bean bag and from a distance, toss onto the completed puzzle. Remove the puzzle piece the bean bag lands on, and sing the song underneath. Put puzzle pieces back in the plastic baggie until the lyric sheet is cleared. Repeat!
