



The hearth, and the fire within, was once the center of domestic and social life because it provided warmth, illuminated homes, and cooked food. Placement in the center of the house maximized the number of people able to get around the warmth of the fire. If Jesus Christ is the center of our homes - the light that illuminates, warms and nurtures - women are the guardians and caretakers of that light. The paper lantern represents women and the things we can do to guard the light in our homes as we follow Christ's doctrines and rely on Him to help us.

Instructions to make paper lantern: Cut on dotted line. Fold in half so the back of "Guardians of the Hearth touches the back of the scripture reference. Cut through the fold and down the printed lines. Unfold and bend paper into a circular shape. Tape end together. Place a tealight candle and holder in center of lantern.
