## THIS LESSON AID

### READ FROM HERE:

*When you come to a dead end or a piece that needs to be rotated.*

Do not yield to emotions such as anger or hurt or defensiveness.

Be cautious with humor. Loud, inappropriate laughter will offend the Spirit.

An enemy to revelation comes from exaggeration or loudness in what is stated

Our daily activities should not distract us from listening to the Spirit.

Haughtiness, pride, and conceit are like stony ground that will never produce spiritual fruit.

Should choices be wrong, they can be rectified through repentance.



### READ FROM HERE:

*Once you move to a new square.*

Fast and pray to find and understand helpful scriptures. Ponder and pray for inspiration. Repeat.

A good sense of humor helps!

Good health practices enhance spiritual communication.

Revelation can also be given in a dream (generally accompanied by a sacred feeling).

Record impressions of the Spirit to better remember revelation.

Ponder scriptural examples that show how our capacity to conquer challenges is strengthened by the Lord in time of need.

Keep the commandments.

We are more easily inspired when we act in behalf of others.

A feeling or prompting comes from God when you feel peace and a quiet, warm feeling.

## TO BEGIN THE GAME, *read this quote:*

"Our Heavenly Father did not put us on earth to fail but to succeed gloriously. It may seem paradoxical, but that is why recognizing answers to prayer can sometimes be very difficult. Sometimes we unwisely try to face life by depending on our own experience and capacity. It is much wiser for us to seek through prayer and divine inspiration to know what to do. Our obedience assures that when required, we can qualify for divine power to accomplish an inspired objective."

## TO END THE GAME, *at the midpoint or final square (depending how long you want to play), read this quote:*

"The more closely you follow divine guidance, the greater will be your happiness here and for eternity—moreover, the more abundant your progress and capacity to serve. I do not understand fully how it is done, but that guidance in your life does not take away your agency. You can make the decisions you choose to make. But remember, the disposition to do right brings peace of mind and happiness."
